Blue Cloud Abbey is a Benedictine Monastery located in Marvin, SD. The Abbey was founded in 1950 and was named after an Elder of the Yankton tribe, Mahpiya To, which means "Blue Cloud." Like all Benedictine monasteries, the community lives according to the rule of Saint Benedict, in which hospitality is a primary focus. Therefore, the Abbey welcomes many guests in their retreat center, camp, and Native American cultural center. Guests are invited to participate in the worship life of the monks, as they pray together the daily office.
