


Brian and Sonya Nash with baby daughter Abigail. Abigail was dedicated to the church on April 7<sup>th</sup>.



Brady & Timothy Sydney were dedicated to the church on April 21<sup>st</sup> by their parents Brian and Crystal Sydney.


## VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL
